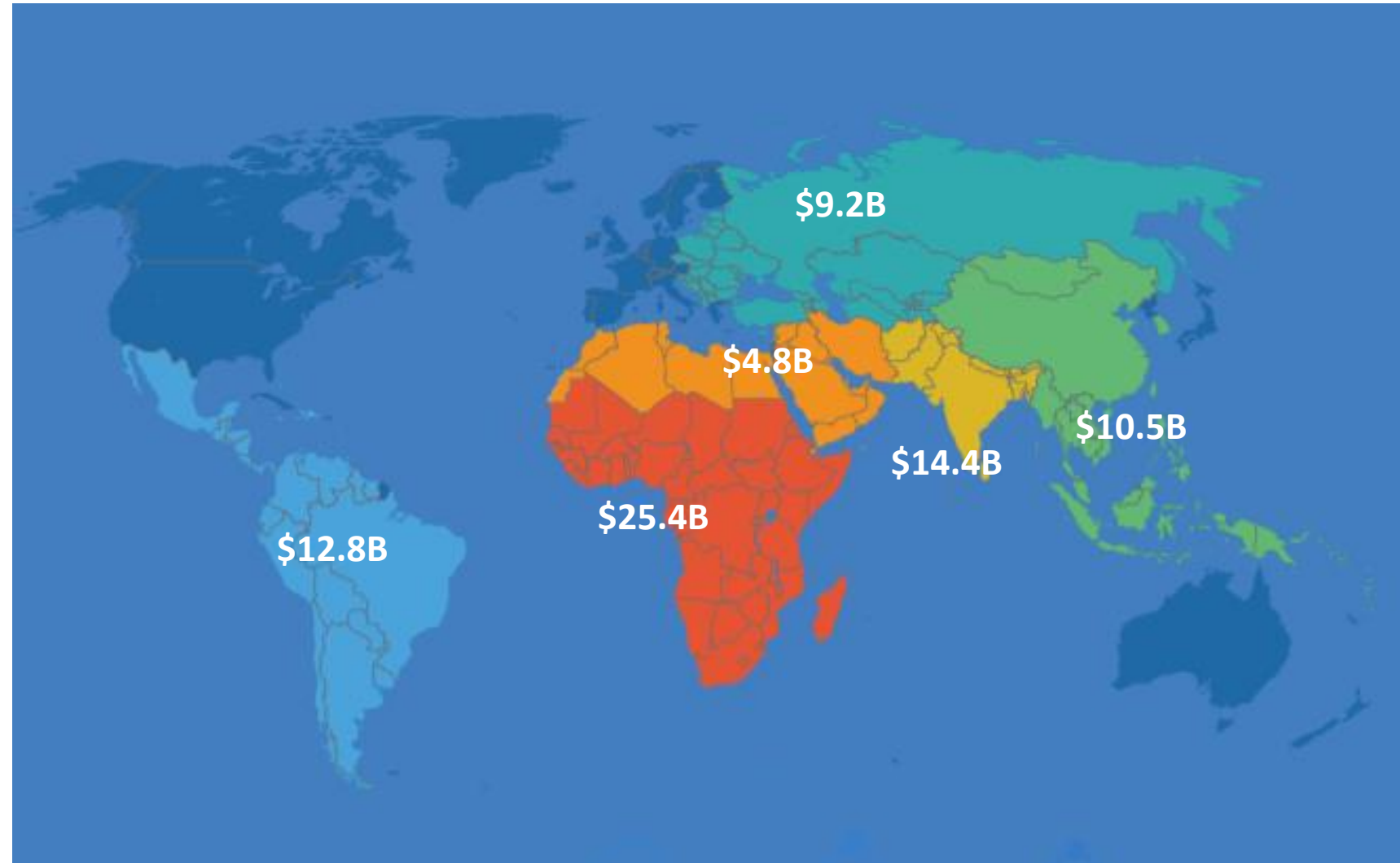

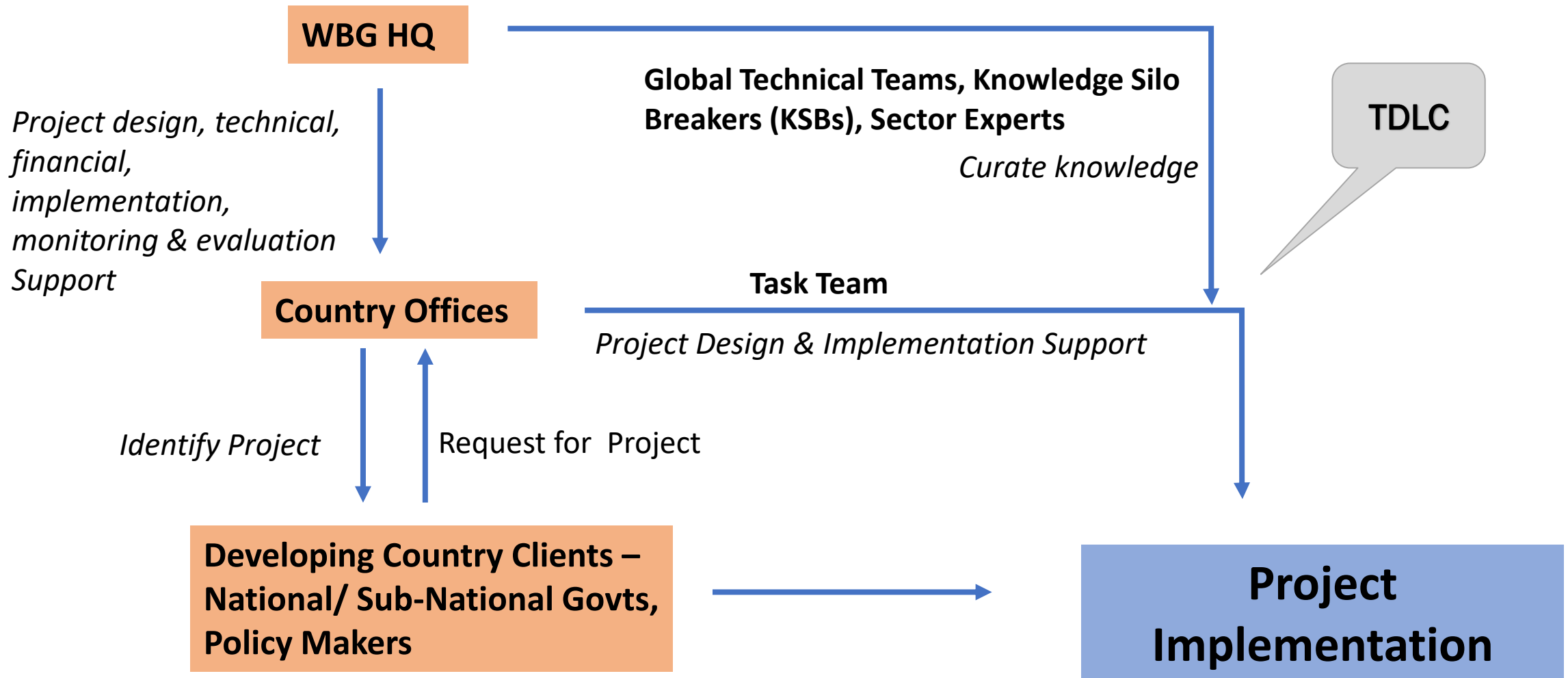

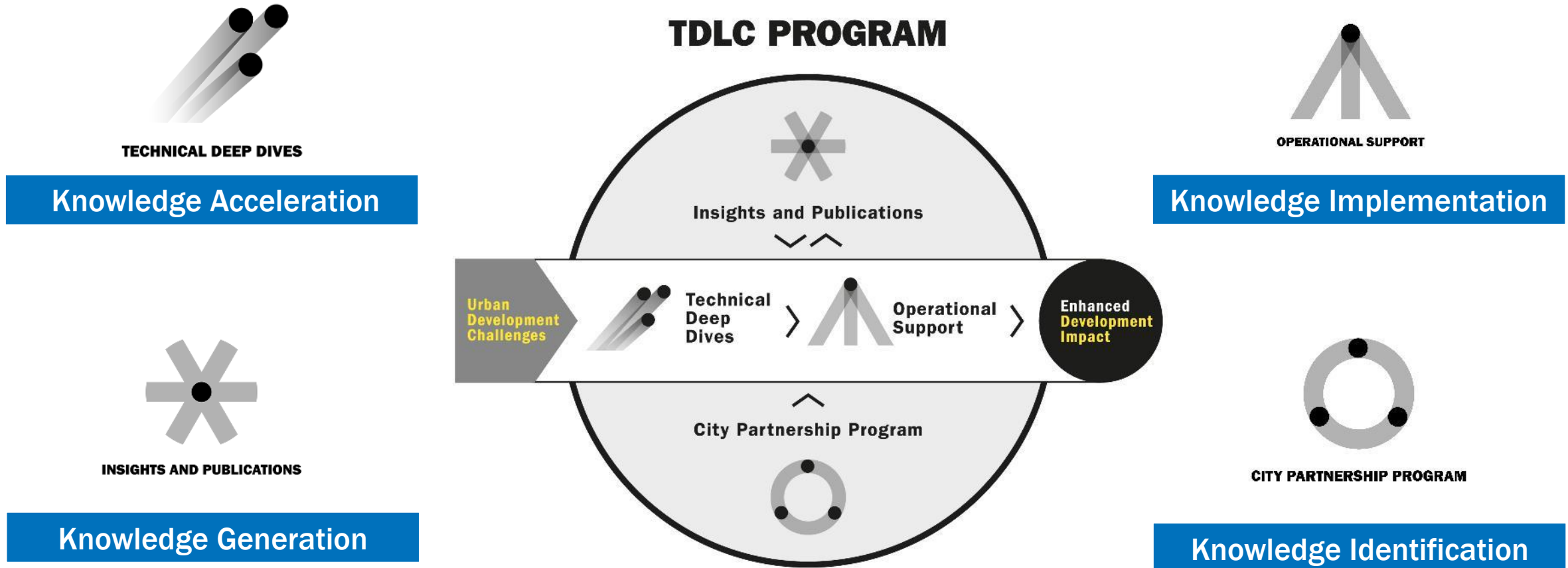
Tokyo Development Learning Centre

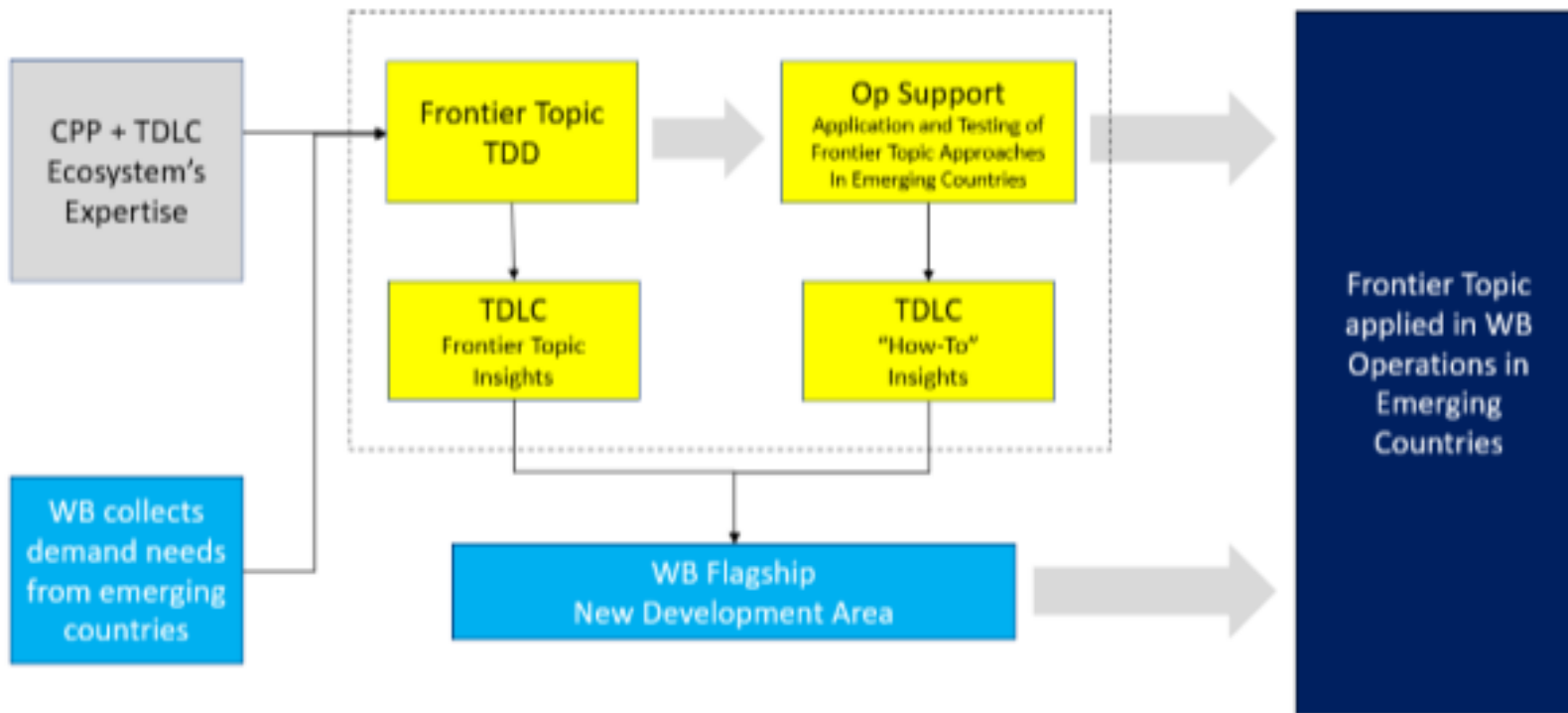
Operationalize Knowledge

Curate Knowledge

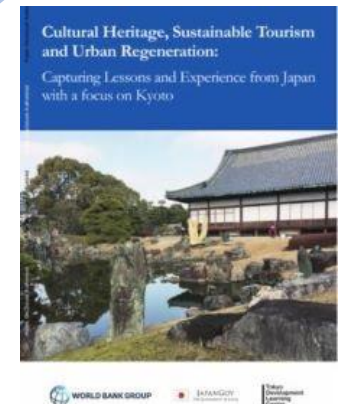
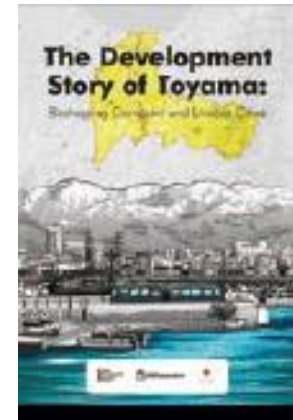
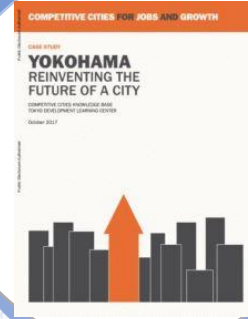


We develop knowledge and insights on frontier and cutting-edge topics to address contemporary challenges and test them through pilot programmes.
