




Tokyo Development Learning Centre

- We collaborate with Task Team Leaders (TTLs) and clients to apply this knowledge.





We <u>present and share</u> <u>selected</u> projects through one-week cohort-based knowledge-sharing program called **Technical Deep Dives (TDDs)**


